Library History and Growth

- 1892 Humble beginnings by the Indianola Reading Club exchanging materials
- 1920's Utilized donated items from the Indianola Chapter of the United Daughters of the Confederacy and the Works Progress Administration.
- 1924 Drew Civic League opened library located in the corner of S. C.
 Atkinson's Main Street drug store then moved to a room over the Merchants and Planter's Bank.
- 1927 Drew library relocated to a room in the Community House.
- 1930 Ruleville Women's Club adopted the Mississippi's Federation's goal "a library in every county". Book exchanges conducted among Moorhead Fine Arts Club members. Community book exchanges conducted in towns of Inverness and Sunflower.
- 1935 The first library supervisor for Sunflower County, Mrs. Gladys Bridges
 Becker, was appointed to provide library services to Baird, Moorhead, Indianola,
 Sunflower, Doddsville, Ruleville, Drew, Sunflower Plantation, and Parchman,
 Mississippi.
- 1938 Sunflower County's first library building, Horace Stansel Memorial Library dedicated. First library board for Sunflower County appointed by County Board of Supervisors.
- 1959 Henry M. Seymour Library opened in Indianola, Mississippi.
- 1961 Sunflower County Library System established.
- 1962 Inverness Public Library opened.
- 1971 Kathy June Sheriff Public Library established in Moorhead, Mississippi.
 Drew Public Library established.
- 1994 Sunflower County Library System Agreement between Sunflower County Board of Supervisors, Sunflower County Library Board of Trustees, City of Drew, Mississippi, Town of Inverness, Mississippi, City of Moorhead, Mississippi, City of Ruleville, Mississippi, and City of Indianola, Mississippi.
